REFRESHMENTS ON CLUB NIGHTS

The licencing laws and the rules of the Gateside Memorial Hotel prevent us selling alcoholic drinks, so unfortunately we cannot run a bar on club nights. There is no problem in bringing anything with you to drink, alcoholic or non-alcoholic, should you wish to do so.

We do have a kitchen and I would like to trial offering tea, coffee, soft drinks and water for those who do not wish to bring their own. This may also provide a small income for the club.

It is envisaged that this will be available on a self-service basis throughout the whole evening. Disposable cups and spoons, sachets of coffee, tea, sugar, milk, biscoff, (all as normally provided in hotel rooms) and boiling water will be provided. The tariff will be displayed and payment will be by an honesty box.

You may be wondering why this less economic sourcing of "crockerly" and consumables has been chosen but it has several advantages. Nothing is lying open or is of questionable cleanliness from a hall cupboard in these Covid times, there is no wastage and it is practical as no-one is required to do any washing up resulting in minimal input.

HALL FLOOR

The hall floor is the original wood which has been sanded and sealed to give a lovely floor of which the hall committee is justifiably proud. Unfortunately, the car park surface is very gritty and I would ask you to wipe your feet well on entry to avoid any damage and perhaps avoid wearing peery heels. The hall committee have been very helpful allowing us to store all our equipment and we want to keep a good rapport with them.
